Our goal is to help bring the deer population on the North Fork to a safe and sustainable level for people, deer and the environment while harvesting venison for personal consumption and donations to food pantries.

Hamilton Archers is currently seeking a limited number new members that are experienced bow hunters and willing to commit to "hunt hard" during the 2016 / 2017 deer season on our acquired properties, most of which have never been hunted in the past.

Member candidates must complete a Membership Application, an interview process and pass a practical archery test.

To become a Hamilton Archer, the candidate must also be mature, responsible, honest and ethical, and have no DEC violations for the past 5 years. Further, a candidate will need to commit to a goal of 50 hunts and/or a harvest of 20 deer for the season.

Hamilton Archers has invested a substantial amount of time and capital in this effort to ensure it's members have the best chance to harvest deer including <u>Liability Insurance Coverage for Landowners</u>, <u>Cellular Trail Cameras</u>, <u>deer stands</u> and marketing efforts to acquire hunting land in order to make our <u>member hunts</u> as productive as possible. In short, we will put you on the deer.
